REACH Registration of Aluminium, Aluminium oxide and Aluminium hydroxide

The dossiers for the joint registration of aluminium, aluminium oxide and aluminium hydroxide have been submitted to European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) in 2010 by the Lead Registrant (LR) on behalf of the Aluminium REACH Consortium. The dossiers were updated and submitted again in 2014. All members of the Consortium have full access to all the data and studies used for the dossier.

For small companies and companies which don't need the access to the full dossier and are only interested in fulfilling the requirements for registration of their substance, there is the possibility to purchase a Letter of Access (LoA) as an alternative to becoming full member of the Consortium.

With the Letter of Access the company will get the security token and the Joint registration name from the LR and use this for their own registration, and in this case only need to fill in the company specific information in the IUCLID file submitted to ECHA. The company will also have access to the Chemical Safety Report (CSR) as required by the REACH legislation.

In order to streamline this process the Consortium has set up a SIEF web site (<https://www.reachsuite.com/EAA090114/cxpweb.nsf>) where companies can log in and request a contract for a LoA. Before doing this the company must have a pre-registration for the substance or if they are too late for this, an enquiry number from ECHA.

With this in place the Consortium can supply the log in details for the web site.

As of 1st December 2022, the current cost for the LoA is € 3500 for tonnage band above 1000 t/year and € 1500 below 1000 t/year.

An administration charge of Euro 500 will be added to each fee level.

After submitting the contract for the LoA on the web site, the Consortium will issue an invoice, and once the payment is confirmed by our bank, the security token will be issued.

Please notice that this valid for 30 days, and if not used by this time the LR needs to issue a new token. The LoA is valid for all legal entities within a company, but they must all be listed in the contract.

After submitting the IUCLID file to ECHA, the company will receive an invoice for the registration fee from ECHA, and after payment of this will receive a REACH registration number. Please notice that each legal entity within a company needs a separate registration.
